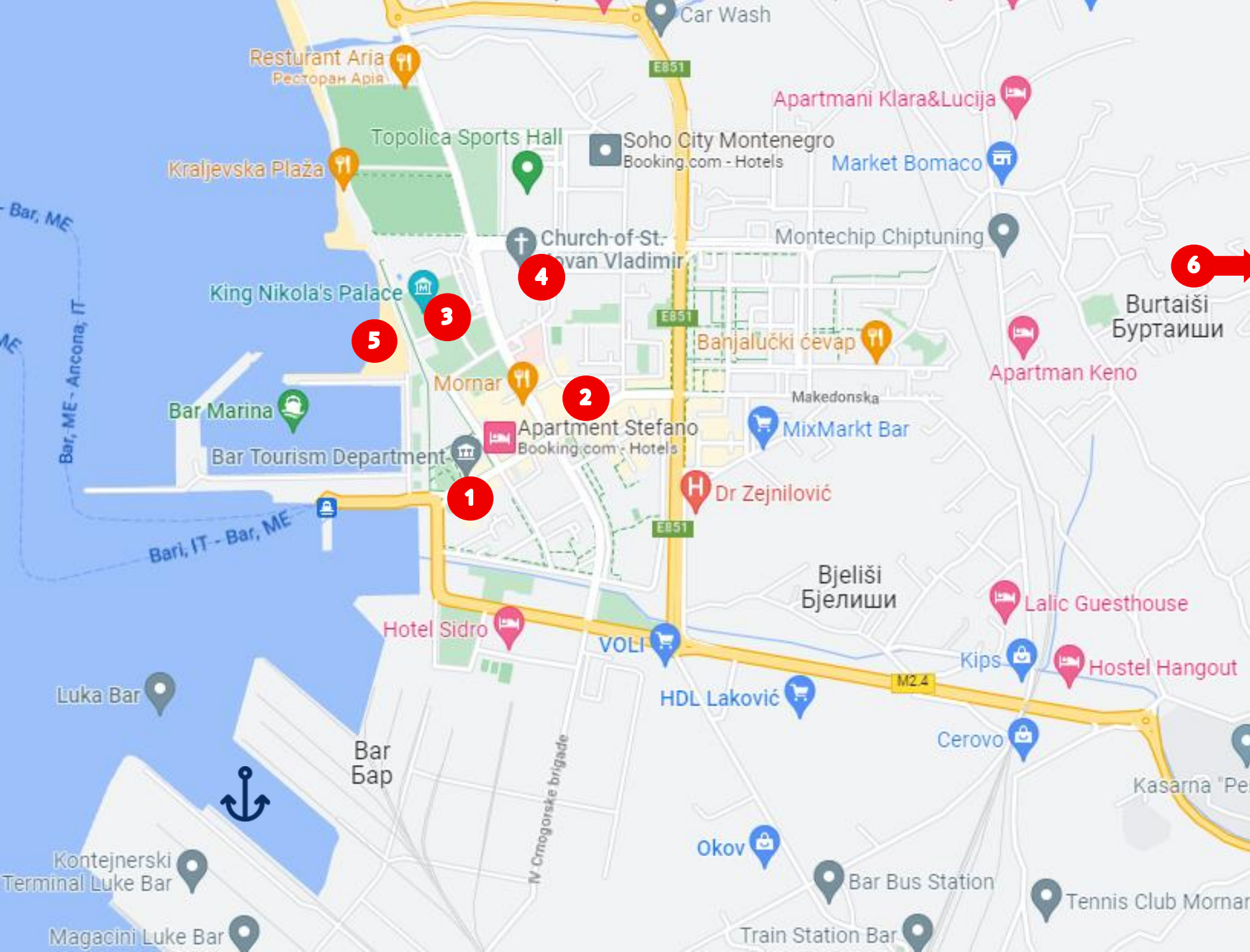
Ship's Location

AT A GLANCE

The picturesque city of Bar lies at the southern edge of Montenegro. With rolling mountains, warm waters and a bustling cityscape, it's a huge tourist destination and a hub for coastal expeditions.

Distance to the central part of the town is 10 minutes by a shuttle bus, organised by the port. As it is an industrial port guests are not allowed to walk in the port.

A Tourist Information Office can be found in front of the Shuttle Bus Drop Off point. Then the marina is a further 5 minute walk from there.

Bar offers plenty of culture and history to discover, nature is right on its doorstep, and a string of pebble beaches to relax on.

DON'T MISS OUT ON

Stari Bar: The Old Town of Bar, which is 4 kilometres away from the centre of New Bar. What makes Stari Bar so important are all the different architectural styles found within the city, including Romanesque, Gothic and Renaissance. During the Ottoman reign, Eastern features were added to the existing medieval architecture to make the city a real melting pot of cultural architecture.

King Nikola's Palace: Situated just about a 15 minute walk from the city centre. The Palace is presenting an elegant facade to the water. It was built in 1885 and now houses a collection of antiques, folk costumes and royal furniture. Its shady gardens contain plants cultivated from seeds and cuttings, collected from all around the world by Montenegro's sailors.

Shopping: A large amount of stores can be found in the centre of the New Bar, just 5 – 10 min walk from the shuttle bus Drop Off point. Here you can pick up clothes, footwear, sports equipment, and food products.

Beach: Barska Plaza Beach is approximately a 10 minute walk from the shuttle bus Drop Off point. This pebble beach reflects the turquoise waters along the coastline. This beach has loungers, umbrellas and a restaurant for the perfect relax beach day. There is also a chance to hop on a catamaran or hire a jet ski for the day.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Skadar Lake Cruise: This is your chance to spend the day cruising on Lake Skadar, the largest lake in the Balkans, which spans the Montenegro-Albania border. After a quick briefing, you'll board an open-sided boat and head out through the lily pads and onto the open water. The route takes you past lakeside villages and islands that house Medieval churches and monasteries. Keep your eyes peeled while you're onboard, too, because the lake is home to more than 260 species of birds, including the rare Dalmatian pelican. After you've made it back to dry land, it's on to the nearby village of Virpazar, where you'll be treated to lunch – fresh fish from the lake comes highly recommended.
