GETTING ABOUT

When we arrive at Bequia you'll find that that we'll be lowering the anchor this time and located just off of the shore, meaning that we'll be operating a tender service to transfer you from ship to shore (Port Elizabeth). The island is only a small island making everything easy to reach.

Once ashore you'll discover that getting around is made extremely easy as the centre of Bequia is only a stones throw from the tender drop-off point. If you wish to walk into the centre then this will only take approximately 5 minutes on foot.

Alternatively, as a very popular mode of transport you'll find taxis in the port area which can help you travel local or further afield. Taxis in Bequia can be great fun; some are open-air pickup trucks with bench seats in the back and wind-generated air-conditioning! If you're thinking of using the local services please ensure that you are confirming the price and currency with the taxi drivers prior to heading off.
