Internet access	Internet points are available throughout the town.	Shopping	Nice walk through the centre, where you can find several shops with international brands. There are also jewellery and watch shops, modern sports clothing and shoe shops. There are many shops, cafes, restaurants and a morning fruit market in the centre. All shops with the arrival of the ship, remain open but don't forget Italians love their 'sieta' so some shops might be closed from 1.30pm till 5.30pm.
Nearest bank	You will find various ATM machines and Banks in the town centere		
Nearest pharmacy	Pharmacies are available in the town centre, and are identified by green crosses displayed outside.		
Nearest beach	Brindisi, has no free and private beaches. To reach the sea need of a means of transport. At the moment there are no public transports. Free and private beaches are about 5 km from the center (Torre Guaceto, Pantagianni)
