AT A GLANCE

Nooked into the south coast of Sardinia, Cagliari is the islands capital city and serves up a historical buffet of sights. The cruise terminal is at Molo Rinascita which is around a 15 minute walk from the city centre.

The local authorities don't allow anyone to walk through the port. If you're not on a Marella Cruises excursion, you'll need to get on the complimentary shuttle bus which will take you to the port gates.

The old town of Cagliari is a hilly area so be prepared for a lot of uphill and downhill walking to reach the historical sights.

DON'T MISS OUT ON

Bastione di Saint Remy: A regal neo-classical structure with a monumental staircase and promenade, a great local hangout area. It's one of the symbols of Cagliari and functions as a gateway from the Villanova quarter to the fortifications of Castello.

Roman Amphitheatre of Cagliari: An ancient Roman Amphitheatre dating back to the 1st and 2nd century AD, it's said to be Sardinia's most important public building of the Roman Period.

Shopping: Via Roma runs through the coastline and has a variety of shops dotted through the Marina area, think bookshops, antiques and even a department store. You'll also find an array of souvenir shops peppered around the old town.

Beaches: Poetto Beach is a popular sandy hotspot filled with Sardinian charm just a hop, skip and jump from the port. You can get there in around 15 minutes either by taxi or you could hop on a public bus from Via Roma.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Cagliari Sightseeing: A cultural melting pot, Cagliari is the capital of Sardinia. It's a real class act, buzzing with cosmopolitan charm yet retaining a great old-fashioned feel. Your tour will start with a panoramic drive to the ancient part of Cagliari and its coastline. Take in the views of notable landmarks such as sanctuary of Bonaria and Poetto beach. Stop for a photo opportunity at the Parco di Monte Urpinu, this lovely park has great views of Cagliari old town. Then its time to head into the old quarter for your walking tour. Sights to cross off your list here include the 17th-century Porta Cristina and the 14th century Elephant Tower, so named after a small marble elephant that sits on one corner. After your walking tour you'll get some free time to browse the shops before you return back to the ship.
