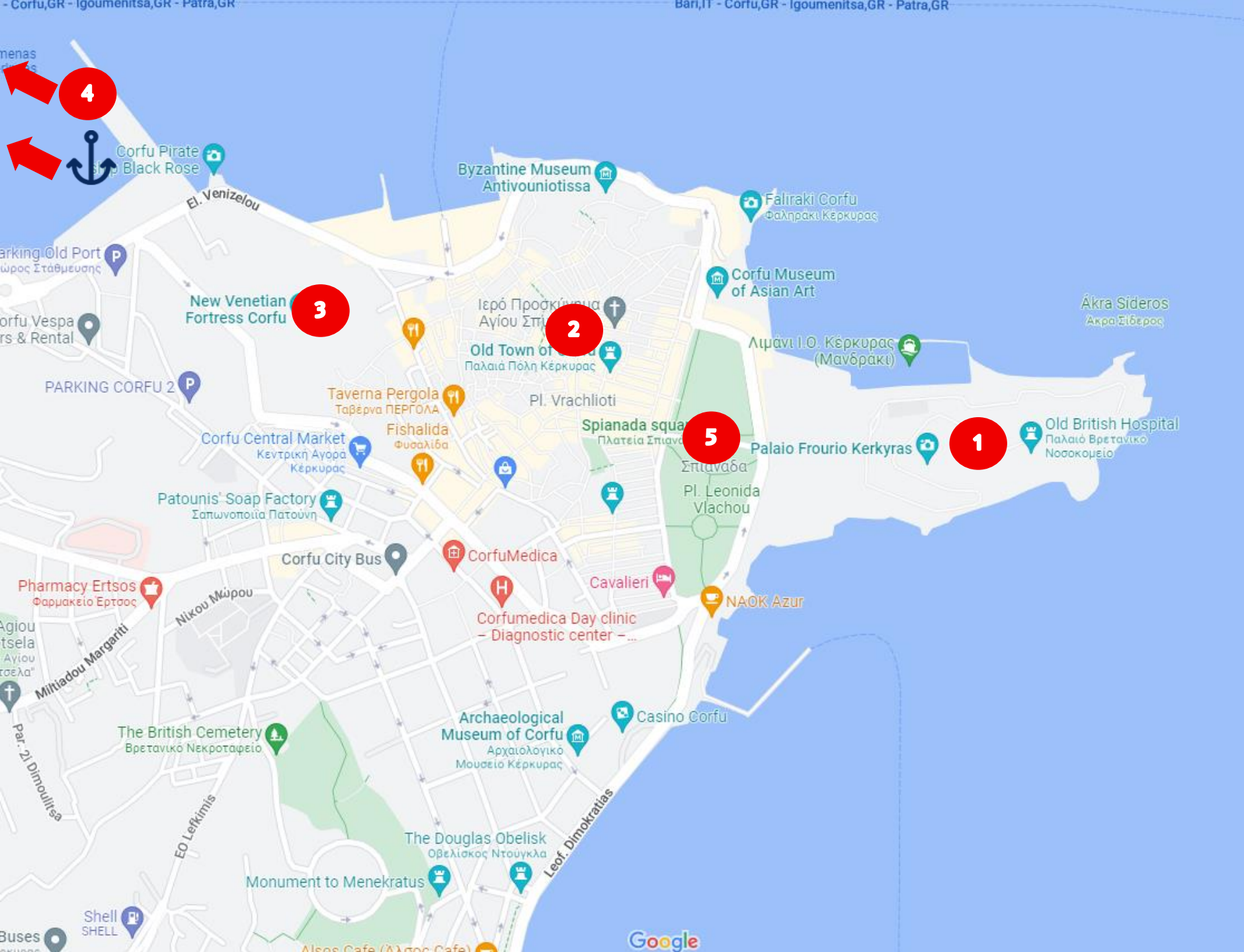

AT A GLANCE

Corfu Old Town is located approximately 1.6 miles from the port and will take around 30 - 40 minutes to walk.

You can find taxis right outside the cruise terminal and it will take you approximately 10 minutes to get into the town centre.

The public bus service is just outside the terminal and will cost around €1.70 each way to get you to Corfu Old Quarter.

There is a Hop-On Hop-Off bus that runs from outside the port gates. Tickets can be purchased onboard. It is best to get the shuttle bus to the terminal building where you can purchase tickets at the ticket office. Then walk towards the exit of the port, where you can pick up the bus. Tickets cost €19 and you can pay using cash or a debit/credit card.

DON'T MISS OUT ON

Achilleion Palace: The Achilleion Palace is ideally located in the picturesque village of Gastouri. This magnificent Palace was built in 1890 exclusively for the empress of Austria.

Bella Vista: Soak up the views at Corfu's most famous lookout point. From here, you can peer over sleepy seaside villages like Paleokastritsa, and the island's entire west coast.

Old Fortress: The old fortress lies on a small, rocky peninsula, immediately east of the old town. Inside the fortress is a small church, in the style of a Doric temple. Around a 15 minute drive away.

Beach: Dassia Beach is approximately 20 minutes drive from the port. Along the water front is a mixture of sand and pebbles.

Shopping: The main shopping street is Theotoki in the new town. This is where all of the Greek boutiques are situated and there's even a small M&S. There are many shops in the old town, approximately 10 minutes drive away.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Bella Vista: Visit some of the most spectacular places in the north of the island. First of all, you'll head to Paleokastritsa, a quiet resort nestled in a beautiful bay. There'll be time to take a coffee break or enjoy an optional boat ride to the caves around the bay at an extra local charge, before heading to Bella Vista, the most famous viewpoint in Corfu. Visit the Byzantine Monastery of Agia Paraskevi where you will meet the three nuns that overlook the monastery and its surroundings, and you'll get some time to capture the magical views overlooking Paleokastritsa and the island's west coast. Then the tour continues via the village of Makrades, the Troumbeta mountain passage and a string of traditional Greek villages before returning to the ship.
