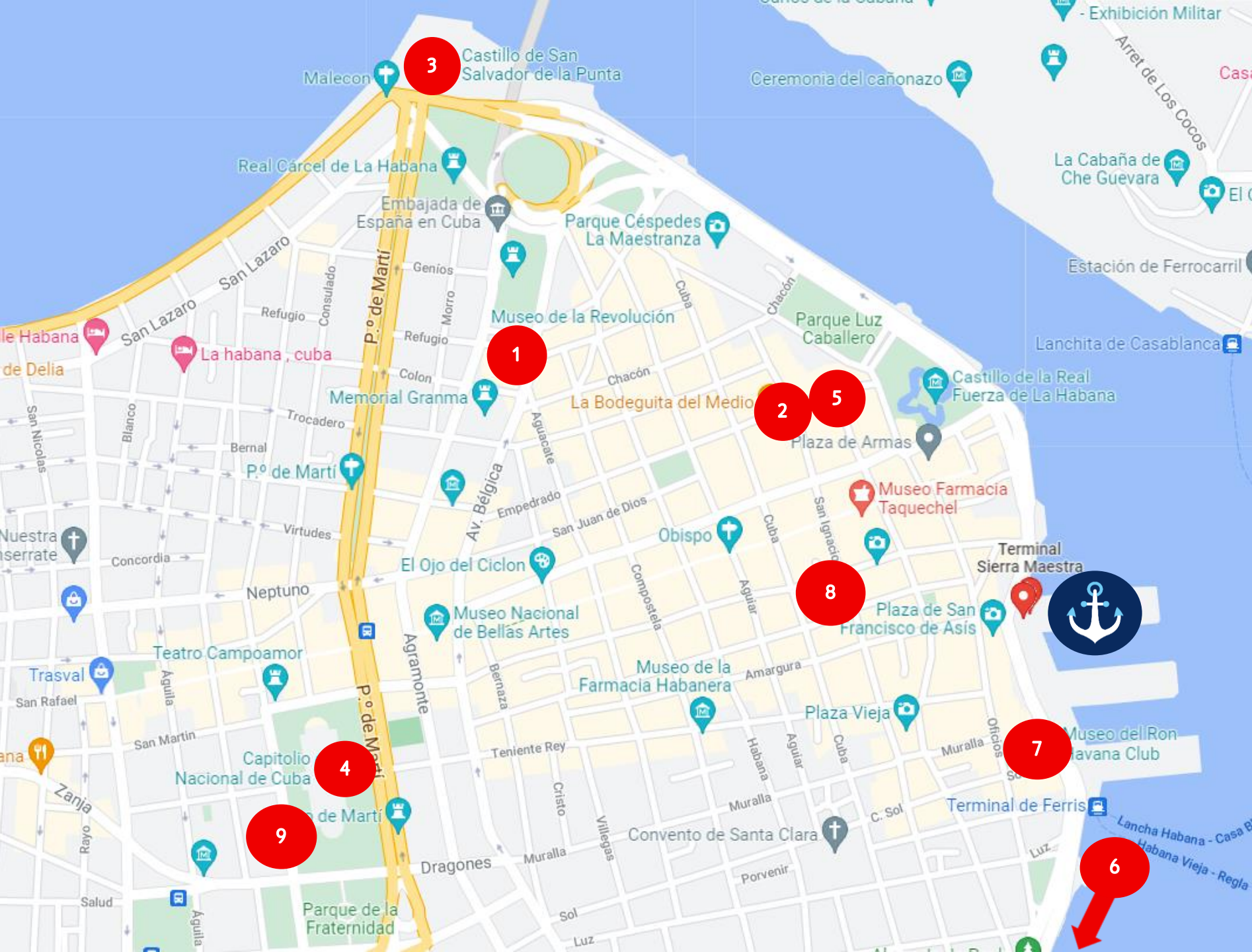

AT A GLANCE

Welcome to Cuba's capital city. Famous for its traditional Spanish architecture, classic American cars and tropical climate. Havana town centre is located a 5 minute walk from where the ship docks. When you come out of the terminal, walk straight ahead into the town centre or along the promenade, also known as 'El Malecón Habanero'.

Different types of taxis can be found around the streets, including tourist taxi's, two-seater bici-taxi's, yellow scooter coco-taxis and classic vintage cars also known as colectivos. If taxi's are not metered, ensure you agree a price before jumping in. We strongly advise you not to use the horse & carriages as they may charge you more than agreed at the end of your ride.

DON'T MISS OUT ON

Museo de la Revolución: Located in the Old Havana section of Havana, in what was the Presidential Palace of all Cuban presidents. Museo de la Revolución became the Museum of the Revolution during the years following the Cuban Revolution.

La Bodeguita del Medio: Located around a 10 minute walk from the port, La Bodeguita del Me dio is known to be the most popular Cuban cocktail bar and music restaurant in Havana, claiming to be the birthplace of the 'Mojito cocktail'.

National Capitol Building: Commissioned by Cuban president Gerardo Machado and built from 1926 to 1929, The National Capitol Building symbolises great architectural wealth. It is located around a 20 minute walk from the port terminal.

Old Havana: Old Havana is well known for it's streets of historic structure, cobbled plazas, castles, cathedrals and classical mansions dating to it's Spanish heyday. It is approximately a 5 minute walk from the port.

Santa María del Mar Beach: Located around a 25 minute drive away, this is the ideal spot for day trippers to catch the sun. You can hire sun loungers and umbrellas and enjoy a couple of beach bars/restaurants that Santa Maria del Mar Beach has to offer.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Cabaret Tropicana - A Paradise Under the Stars:

Paris got the Moulin Rouge, New York got Studio 54, and Havana got the Tropicana. This world-famous club is the city's epicentre of glitz and glamour and a must for theatre and cabaret-lovers. All the acts perform, sing in Spanish & dance on an open-air stage cocooned by tropical greenery. As well as your seat, this tour entitles you to a small welcome glass of sparkling wine and a bit of Havana Club rum to enjoy throughout the performance.
