## Hvar, Croatia

<b>Port information</b>			
<b>Cruise terminal</b>	Hvar port.	<b>Terminal facilities</b>	There is not terminal building but all facilities are available in the town.
<b>Currency</b>	Croatian Kuna. Foreign exchange is available from reception on deck 4. Major credit cards are accepted in most shops, cafes and restaurants. Bank and ATM machines are available in the town centre.		
<b>Language</b>	Croatian but English is not widely spoken but is often understood.	<b>Tourist information</b>	200 meters distance from the port.
<b>Getting around</b>			
<b>Taxis</b>	Are available in the port.	<b>Main highlights</b>	<p>Franciscan Monastery - built in 15th century as a retreat for sailors. Within the monastery there are the artifacts exhibited in the monastery collection which is also the oldest on the island. It consists of paintings, manuscripts, old coins and incunabula.</p> <p>The Arsenal – Hvar town was built in the 13th century. The theatre was built on the first floor of the arsenal in 1612. It is one of the oldest in Europe and the first municipal one as well</p> <p>The Cathedral of St. Stephan - stands on the eastern side of the main square. It was built on the site of an early 6th century church. Present appearance the Cathedral received in the 16th and 17th century. Hvar town loggia and a clock tower from the 15th century together are the only remains of the former Governor's Palace.</p>
<b>Distance to town centre</b>	The port is in the town centre and the best way to reach it is by foot.		
<b>Other Highlight</b>	<p>The island of Hvar is the queen of the Croatian Dalmatian islands. It has been famous since the antique because of its important strategic and nautical position, the rich of the various historical periods, the culture and natural monuments and the literature.</p> <p>The mild climate, the warm winters and pleasant summers Hvar welcomes many guests, scientists and travelers, who are attracted by the dense Mediterranean nature, rich tradition and architecture, and nightlife.</p>		
<b>Essential Information</b>			
<b>Internet access</b>	In the town centre, most of restaurants and cafe's will have a free Wi-Fi access.	<b>Shopping</b>	At the main square of the town you can find beautiful tiny streets of the historical town centre with small boutiques, jewellery shops, souvenir shops, art galleries and shops selling local handicraft.
<b>Nearest bank</b>	In the town centre.		
<b>Nearest pharmacy</b>	In the town centre.		
<b>Nearest beach</b>	<p>Pokonji Dol - a gravel cove with pebble beach, not far away from town.</p> <p>Mekicevica - only 2.5 km east of the center of town, it consists of two pebble beaches.</p>
