AT A GLANCE

Set along a wide horseshoe-shaped bay, Koper's a Medieval town where old and new go hand-in-hand. Lose yourself in the maze of streets, passing historical sights and browsing chic shops along the way.

Koper is very accessible. You can walk around 400 metres and be in the heart of the shops and restaurants within just a few minutes. Turn right when leaving port, then take a flight of stairs to the left which goes from the quayside to the town center. Alternatively, directly opposite the port you can gain access to town via the glass lift.

Taxis are also available from outside of the port. Most fares are set, agree a price with the before entering the taxi. Bus stops can be found on the Piranska Cesta street, opposite the factory outlet. This will take about 15 minutes to walk.

DON'T MISS OUT ON

Piran Town: Around a 30 minute drive away is Piran Town. It sits prettily at the tip of a narrow peninsula. Its Old Town is a gem of Venetian Gothic architecture. Fall in love with the atmospheric winding alleyways, the sunsets and the seafood restaurants.

Tito Square: Slovenia's well-preserved medieval old town has impressive buildings and lovely squares to walk through. The beautiful Cathedral Of Marys Assumption lies next to a 54 metre high bell tower which are both well worth a visit.

Praetorian Palace: This picturesque palace was once the headquarters of the city's rulers and today it serves as an important protocol building and town hall. Guided tours are €5 for adults and €4 for children.

Beaches: Portoroz is a Blue Flag, white sandy beach, the only sand beach in Slovenia. It is around a 20 minute drive away. There aren't many facilities available on the beach

Shopping: The shops are found in the old part of Koper town. There is also a shopping mall called Planet Tus, which is approximately 30 minutes walk from the port.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Explore Postojna Cave: Explore the world famous Postojna Caves. Enter the mysterious world of underground caves and echoing halls and be mesmerised by disappearing rivers and babbling brooks. A train will take you through the halls and corridors chiselled by the Pivka River. The remarkable 'brilliant' stalagmite, and the 'spaghetti' and 'congress' halls will take your breath away. Not to mention the artificial pool with the mysterious 'human-fish' in it.
