AT A GLANCE

Montego Bay and its community, also familiarly known as 'MoBay' is one of the most popular resort destinations in Jamaica.

The distance from the main terminal to the town is approximately a 12-15 minute drive. Minibuses can also be taken from the port to the town independently.

Taxis line up at the main terminal but make sure you are hiring a licensed JUTA taxi and confirm the price δ destination before entering. Other licensed transport operators include MAXI and JCAL.

DON'T MISS OUT ON

The Hip Strip: The popular 'Hip Strip' also known as Gloucester Avenue includes a variety of different souvenir shops, restaurants, clothing supermarkets and arts and crafts items. It is around a 12-15 minute drive from the cruise port.

James Parish Church: Regarded as the finest church on the island, this eighteenth century masterpiece is a beloved attraction. It was built between 1775 and 1782 in the shape of a Greek cross, and further rebuilt due to the 1957 March earthquake.

Dunn's Waterfalls: Discover one of Jamaica's most unique and sought-after attractions. Dunns Waterfall is well known for its fascinating 600ft falls located in the parish of St. Ann Ocho Rios, which is around a 1 hour and 45 minute drive away.

Doctor's Cave Beach: Famous for it's crystal-clear turquoise water and near-white sand, this treasured beach is located approximately a 12-15 minute drive away from the cruise port.

Cash withdrawal: There is an ATM inside the terminal building that you can withdraw US Dollars for a charge of around \$6.

Shopping: Located on Jamaica's elegant corridor 'The Shoppes' at Rose Hall is a new complex. Renewed for offering the best in duty free shopping for Montego Bay. It is around a 30 minute drive from the cruise port.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Dunn's River Falls Express: Dunn's River Falls are a Jamaican national treasure. And this tour gives you a chance to don your swimming gear and get up close to its plunge-pools, waterfalls and thermal springs. You'll form a human chain and, led by guides, climb the waterfalls. Check out the tropical backdrop of ferns, bamboos and orchids along the way, and pause for a natural massage under the cascading water. If you'd rather not get wet, you can relax on the viewing platform and take it all in from dry land. When you've had your fill of exploring, you will take the scenic drive back to port.
