Port information

Currency

The currency used is Euros however debit and credit cards are widely accepted. Banks and ATM machines are available in the centre and currency exchange is also available at reception on deck 5.

Language

The official language is Spanish.

Getting around

Distance to town

The old town is approximately 1 hour walk, following the harbour in the direction of the cathedral.

Main Highlights

Gothic Cathedral is a breath-taking gothic structure. The interior was partly designed by Antonio Gaudi and opens 10.00 -14.15. There's a small entrance fee.

Getting about

The City Sightseeing tourist bus stops at the bus stop outside the terminal building. This is a 'hop on hop off' bus and tickets can be purchased on the bus.

Museu de Mallorca is an archaeological museum filled with relics from different eras. It has a section devoted to the arts from a mix of Spanish artists. Opening hours from 10.00 – 19.00 with a small entrance fee.

Taxis

Taxis are available outside the port terminal. Although taxis are metered, please ensure you agree a rate with the taxi driver before making your journey.

Beliver Castle is an unusual 14th century castle with a unique round tower set atop a pleasant park. Open from 08.00 – 20.30.

Local Buses

There's a bus stop outside the terminal that has a map showing bus numbers. Buses are inexpensive and run regularly. The number 1 bus runs directly opposite the port and costs €1.50 for a single ticket and you must have the exact change.

Soller Train – Take the local bus to Placa de Espanya, which is only approx €1.50. Train times are 10.10/ 10.50/ 12.15/ 1.30 & 15:10. The return train times from Soller are 10.50/ 12.15/ 14.00 & 18.30. The cost is approx. 21euros.

Palma Aquarium is located 15km from the port opening from 9.30 – 18.30. Last entrance into the park is at 17.00. Taxis cost approximately €20-25. The entrance fee is approximately adults €23, children €14. You can catch local buses, number 25 and 15 (Cost €1.25) running every 15 minutes from Placa Espanya.

Mass times in Palma at Palma Cathedral are 09.00 and 19.00. Opening times of Palma Cathedral are 10.00 –16.15.

Internet access

There's internet access in the bowling alley and snooker hall in the Porto Pi shopping area.

Nearest beaches

Cala Major is the closest and easiest beach. It takes approximately 10 minutes to reach by taxi or bus.
