Getting around

Distance to town centre	The town can be reached by walking approximately 250 metres from the pier. The Amphitheatre is about 100 metres from the pier.	Main highlights	<p>The Arena – the 6th largest surviving Roman amphitheatre towers over the nearby buildings. This huge structure was barely saved from destruction several times during its life, mostly by various Venetians with plans to take it to Venice stone by stone as demonstration of the might of the Venetian empire. Entry costs approximately 50 Croatian Kuna and allows access to wander the inside of the colosseum and visit the caverns beneath. The audio tour is very worthwhile.</p> <p>The Forum – is the main square in the centre of the city. The square is built on the place of the ancient Roman forum. On the square there is the city hall that was built in the 10th century and the Temple of August, from the first century.</p> <p>Brijuni – a group of islands famous for their scenic beauty. They are a holiday resort and a Croatian National Park. They were also settlement in roman times and were part of Republic of Venice. Boats go from a small town near Pula named Fazana.</p> <p>If you have any questions or queries please visit Destination Services, we're always happy to help with planning your time ashore.</p>																																								
Taxis	The taxi station is around 200 metres from the pier and payment has to be made in Cash in Croatian Kuna. We recommend agreeing a price before taking the journey.
