AT A GLANCE

Rhodes, the largest of Greece's Dodecanese islands, is known for its beach resorts, ancient ruins and remnants of its occupation by the Knights of St. John during the Crusades. The city of Rhodes has an Old Town featuring the medieval Street of the Knights and the castle like Palace of the Grand Masters.

It'll take you around 15 minutes to walk into the old town. Follow the water front to the right where you will see the pedestrian crossing to the archway of the old city walls.

If you wish to travel to the new town of Rhodes then this will take you another 10 minutes walk from the old town.

Taxis are available from outside the port gates. Fares are usually charged at one euro per kilometre.

The bus station is located on the waterfront, turn right outside the port gates and walk for approximately 20 minutes.

DON'T MISS OUT ON

The Palace of the Grand Master: Used to home the Knights of Rhodes, The medieval castle sits proudly within the city walls in showing the influence of Gothic architecture.

The Acropolis: Sits high above the picturesque fishing village of Lindos \mathcal{E} doesn't just provide history but also providing you with beautiful cobbled streets with restaurants \mathcal{E} shops.

There is a small **shingle beach** close to the cruise port. Elli beach is about a 25 to 30 minute walk away. The best beaches are Kalithea or Falaraki. Kalithea beach is approximately a 10 minute taxi ride away and Falaraki around 25 minutes.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Discover Rhodes: This trip is a half day taster of the wonderful city of Rhodes. First of all, you'll visit the heart of the town, the Mandraki harbour and a glistening collection of luxury yachts. Government buildings from the Italian era, pretty pavement cafés and colourful boats dominate the scenery in these parts.
