£1.00 GBP = \$1.27 USD approximately.

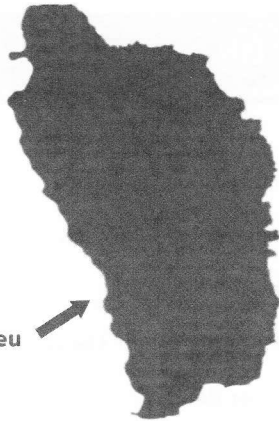


English is the official language spoken in the island along with the traditional French Creole.

GETTING ABOUT

When we arrive at the port of Roseau you'll find that getting around is made extremely easy due to the distance that the cruise ship is located to the local town area. If you're heading out on foot then the town is around a five to ten minute walk.

There are two main docking locations at Roseau. If we dock at Woodbridge there'll be a walk of around 15 minutes or a short taxi journey into the town.

Taxis can be found opposite both docking locations. They're easily identified by the letters 'H, HA or HB' on their registration plates. Prices should be set and advertised. Always confirm the price and the currency you would like to pay in before setting off.

Dominica has a reliable public transportation system with mainly private minibus operators. Bus stops can be found at certain points throughout the town depending on your destination. The bus fares are all set fares.

TOP TIPS

SHOWSTOPPER

Ti Tou Gorge

Ti Tou Gorge means "Little Throat" and this special attraction was formed by volcanic lava which cooled and split open, leaving this natural cave. Find waterfalls, sparkling with light filtered from the forest canopy above.

CULTURE VULTURES

Botanical Gardens

Pay a visit to the Dominica Botanic Gardens with over forty acres of garden including orchid trees, bottle palms and the Caribbean Wood tree & within the gardens you'll find the Parrot Research Centre.

SHOPPING

Rosaeu Town

The local shopping centres are located in and around the town. The nearest shopping centre is Whitchurch IGA Supermarket. You'll also find souvenir stalls near our docking location as well that provide nice family gifts to take home.

SUN SEEKERS

Mero Beach

You will not find many beaches located close by to the port but if you do wish to head out then the nearest is the black sandy Mero Beach. This is a 30 minute taxi ride & always agree a price before departing.
