## Santa Cruz, Tenerife

#### Port information

Currency

The currency in Tenerife is Euro. Foreign exchange is available from reception onboard on Deck 5. Major credit & debit cards are widely accepted.

Language

Spanish. The local dialect is Canario.

#### Getting around

Distance to town centre

The town centre is approximately a 15 minute walk from the ship. Main highlights

Parque Garcia Sanabria is on the northern fringe of the city centre. This city park has delightful collections of Mediterranean and subtropical tree and flowers with various water features.

Getting about

The local bus station is approximately a 25 minute walk from the port. From the port road, follow the directions to the town until you reach a white arch auditorium (the building with the large wave design). The bus station is across the road from here. Information on services and times are available from the station.

Iglesias de Nustra Senora de la Concepcion. Don't miss the striking bell tower of the city's oldest church, which has a tiled roof and traditional Islamic - style architecture. The present church was built in 17th and 18th centuries but the original went up in

Taxis

Taxis are available on the quayside. They are generally not metered so ensure that you agree a price with the driver before getting in. We advise that taxis cost around €1 per minute.

Iglesia de San Francisco is a pretty baroque church from the 17th and 18th centuries.

1498, just after the island was conquered.

Main highlights

The majority of Santa Cruz's sights are within easy walking distance of the waterfront Plaza Espana, with its controversial centrepiece, a memorial to the fallen of the 1936-39 civil wars.

Museo de Bella's Artes is home to an eclectic mix of paintings by mainly Spanish, Canarias and Flemish artists. There are also sculptures and temporary exhibitions.

The fort of Castillo de San Juan, built in 1644, defended Santa Cruz and is now one of the few fortifications preserved in the city.

TEA Tenerife Espacio de las Artes is the city's new slick art exhibition space, only opened in 2008. The emphasis is on photography, modern art and social documentary.

Parque Maritimo Ceasar Manrique is located just beyond the fort. Here you will find a park and wonderfully designed swimming pools and gardens.

Museo Militar de Almeyda explains the military history of the islands and is full of several centuries' worth of 'technological marvels'. Much of the museum is devoted to the successful defence of the city, brought alive by a superb 30 metre scale model of flagship Theseus.

The Auditorio de Tenerife is designed as a white wave and was designed by internationally renowned Spanish architect Santiago Calatrava.

> Teatro Guimera is one of the city's architectural highlights is the 19th century Teatro Guimera, fronted by a suitable theatrical giant mask sculpture. The sumptuous interior is reminiscent of Madrid's Teatro Real, with semicircular balconied seating and plenty of guilt.

Museo de la Naturaleza y el Hombre is the city's number one attraction and is one of the best museums in the Canary Islands. The museum features natural science and archaeology set inside a former civil hospital. The highlights are most definitely the Guanche mummies and skulls. In addition there are informative displays on the geology and wildlife of the islands and all sorts of interactive displays. Sadly, though, signage is only in Spanish however translation cards are given at the entrance. Audio guides are also available in English.
