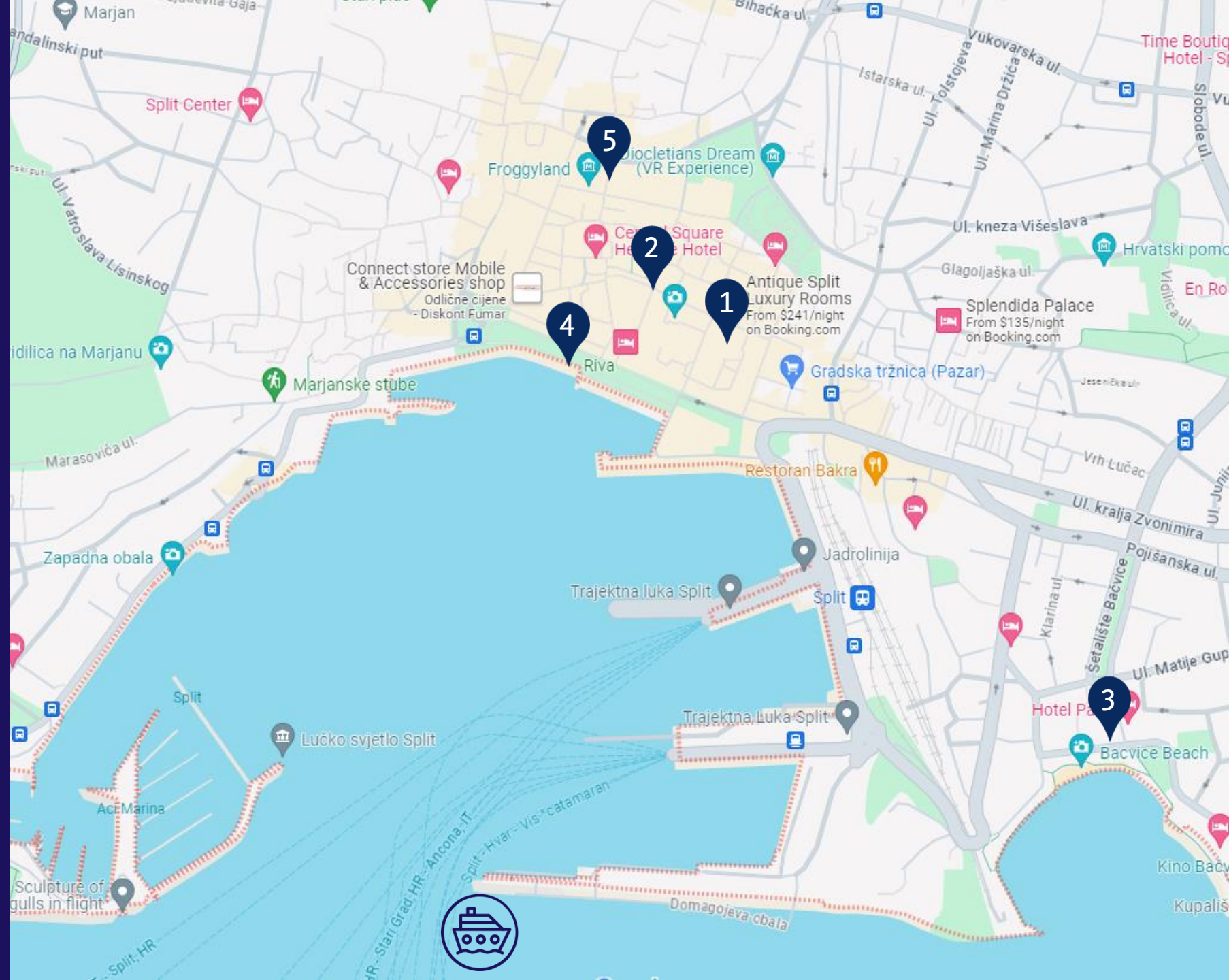

AT A GLANCE

Right in the heart of the Dalmatia region, this heart-stealer of a city has got pavement cafés, plenty of history, and a confetti of islands sprinkled off its coast.

The town is around a 15-20 minute walk around the bay which can be easily seen from the ship. You can reach and visit most popular tourist destinations in Split on foot, as everything is very close together.

The local bus services run fairly frequently when cruise ships are in port. You can buy a ticket on the bus for Area 1 in the town centre. Local taxis are available. We suggest that you agree a price with the driver before entering the taxi.

DON'T MISS OUT ON

Diocletian's Palace: The palace is a UNESCO-listed fortress from the Roman times with 220 buildings in its boundaries, home to around 3000 people. Around a 10 minute walk, it is the perfect way to spend a few hours.

The Krka National Park: The national park is packed with waterfall splashed countryside and is a beautiful backdrop for some stunning photos. It takes around 2 hours to drive to Krka Waterfalls. Just so you know... it is no longer possible to swim at the falls.

Omis: A 40 minute drive will get you to Omis. This town isn't short of things to do. Visit the Mirabella Fortress and Starigrad Fortress, gaze at the churches or relax on the sand beach.

Marjan Hill viewpoint: It will take approximately 2.5 hours to climb the hill to the viewpoint which overlooks the entire Old Town. You'll travel past the Church of St Nicholas on your way to the top for truly glorious views.

Beaches: Bacvice beach is a small covered sandy beach approximately 30 minutes walk from the main harbor area to the right over the bridge.

Shopping: In the center you will find a variety of shops in the narrow winding streets selling souvenirs, local artifacts, clothing & shoes. There is also a daily market offering a variety of goods.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Split Walking Tour: What better way to explore the picturesque city of Split than on foot! Split, Dalmatia's largest city, has a lot to offer the visitor, from cultural and historical monuments to a rich choice of shops and elegant sea-front cafes. You will walk with your guide from the pier towards the old part of Split, where you will find the impressive 3rd century Diocletian's Palace. Here you will visit the cellars, the Peristyle, the Golden and Silver Gates, the Cathedral (Mausoleum of Emperor Diocletian), the Temple of Jupiter and other interesting and historic sights. Following that you will walk around the 'heart' of the Old Town and finally you will be given free time to shop and take pictures.
