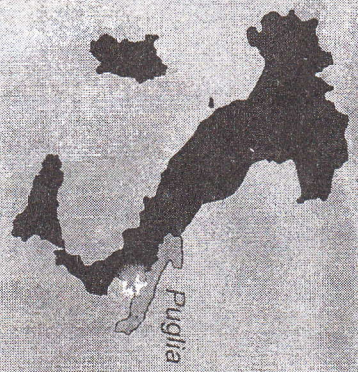

## Taranto, Italy

### Port information

### Getting around

<b>Distance to town centre</b>	2.5km from the port area and approximately a 30 minute walk	<b>Main highlights</b>	The <b>Archaeological Museum</b> of Taranto houses a treasure trove of archaeological finds from prehistoric times to the classical period.
<b>Taxis</b>	Taxis can be found within the port area. The fare's will vary based on the distance; €10 for Aragonese Castle and the Old City; €20 for the City Mall.		From Via Duomo, you will reach the <b>Doric columns</b> , testimony of Greek foundation, and the <b>Aragonese Castle</b> , the <b>Sea Sentinel</b> and the fairway with stunning views of the Swing Bridge.
<b>Local buses</b>	Local buses are limited in Taranto and do not run very frequently. <b>The port authorities will be operating a complimentary shuttle bus service for guests wishing to go ashore independently.</b>		<b>The Swing Bridge</b> (The Ponte Girevole), built in 1887, runs across the navigable ship canal that joins Mar Piccolo (Little Sea) with Mar Grande (Big Sea) and stretches along 89.9 metres (295 ft). When the bridge is open, the two ends of the city are disconnected.
<b>Main highlights</b>	Taranto Old Town starts from <b>Piazza Fontana</b> and continues in a maze of streets and alleys with the stories of fisherman, craftsmen and labourers. Taranto is the capital of Magna Grecia.		
	Houses, palaces, convents frame the <b>Cathedral Basilica</b> with the baroque splendour of the <b>Chapel of San Cataldo</b> , the patron of the city who comes from Ireland.

<b>Tourist information</b>	Inside the port area close to the ship and also within the Old Town and Downtown.	<b>Shopping</b>	Just a short walk from the dockside there are many cafes, bars, shops and restaurants. There are a selection of local shops in the town centre selling a range of souvenirs and handmade produces.

<b>Nearest beaches</b>	There are no sandy beaches within easy walking distance in Taranto.	As with all tourist destinations, always ensure you keep a close eye on your valuables.
