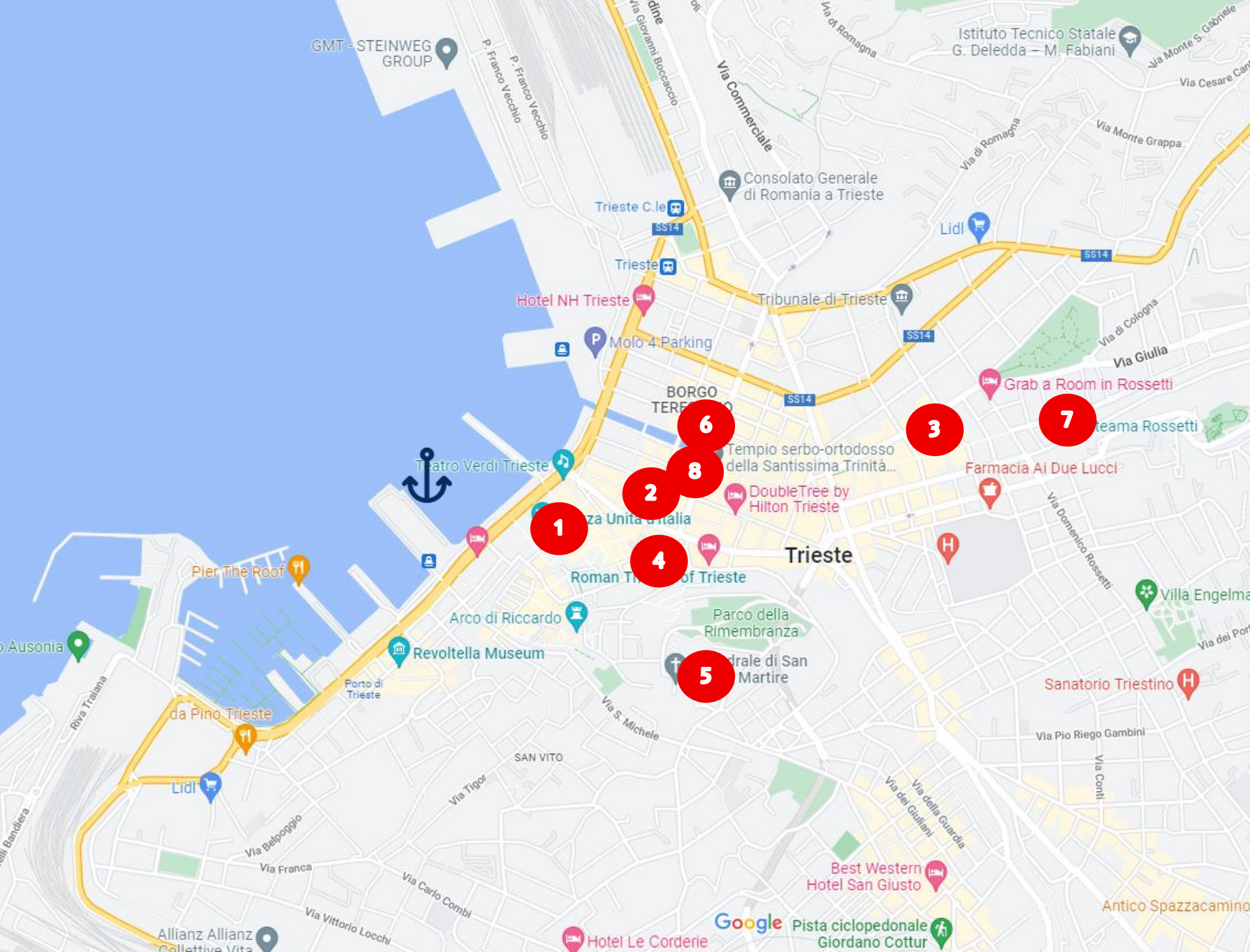

AT A GLANCE

This Italian city showcases cobbled, café-lined piazzas, Baroque churches and an old town that's packed with pastel-coloured buildings. It's a great jumping-off point for trips to scenery-laden Slovenia, too, as the city nuzzles up against the border.

Trieste town centre is easily accessible by foot and the town is only around a 10-15 minute walk away.

Why not jump on the hop-on hop-off bus 'Hop Tour' for €14. The service operates from the docks of Trieste, in front of Piazza Unità d'Italia - just across from the port at 10.00, 12.15, 14.00, 15.45. There are 13 different stops. (Timings subject to change).

DON'T MISS OUT ON

San Giusto hill: This is the first human settlement where you'll find a Medieval cathedral and castle, plus terraces with standout city views. This is approximately a 25 minute walk.

Cathedral of San Giusto: The façade is adorned with a delicate and elegant Gothic rose window. The solid, squat bell tower incorporates the remains of the Roman propylaeum. A 20 minute walk away.

Piazza Unita d'Italia: This is the main square of Trieste and it is considered the largest seafront square in Europe. With cafes galore and beautiful architecture, this is a must visit. Just a 15 minute walk away.

Postojna Caves: The caves have got a natural concert hall with impressive acoustics. Take an unforgettable ride on Postojna Cave's underground train and experience a subterranean paradise shaped over millions of years. A 45 minute drive away.

Beaches: Less known for its sandy beaches, the nearest and best is 'Barcola beach' which is a paved boardwalk with sea access for swimming and kayaking, overlooked by terrace bars. It can be reached in a 10 minute drive.

Shopping: There are two food markets for a chance to sample the local cuisine. The markets are located at the corner of Via Carducci & Via della Majolica and the open-air market is on Ponte Ponterosso. A 10 minute walk away is Viale XX Settembre where you can stroll the streets browsing clothes, accessory and jewellery shops.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Ljubljana - The Capital of Slovenia: With its grand architecture and thriving café culture, Ljubljana is Slovenia's answer to Prague. On this tour, we'll whisk you over the Italian border and take you on a two-hour walking tour through this charm-packed city. Ljubljana's origins are as ancient as they come – it's said that the mythical Greek hero, Jason, founded the place after stealing the Golden Fleece. These days, it's the Baroque Old Town that gets all the attention. It's nestled on the right bank of the Ljubljanica River, at the foot of forested Castle Hill. You'll have a chance to duck inside Ljubljana Cathedral, with its peaches and cream exterior, before having a look at the burnished insides of the Church of the Annunciation. You'll also wander past a dragon-topped bridge and the fruit stalls of the Central Market. Afterwards, you'll have plenty of free time to dig around the Old Town or kick back in one of the city's ubiquitous coffee shops.
