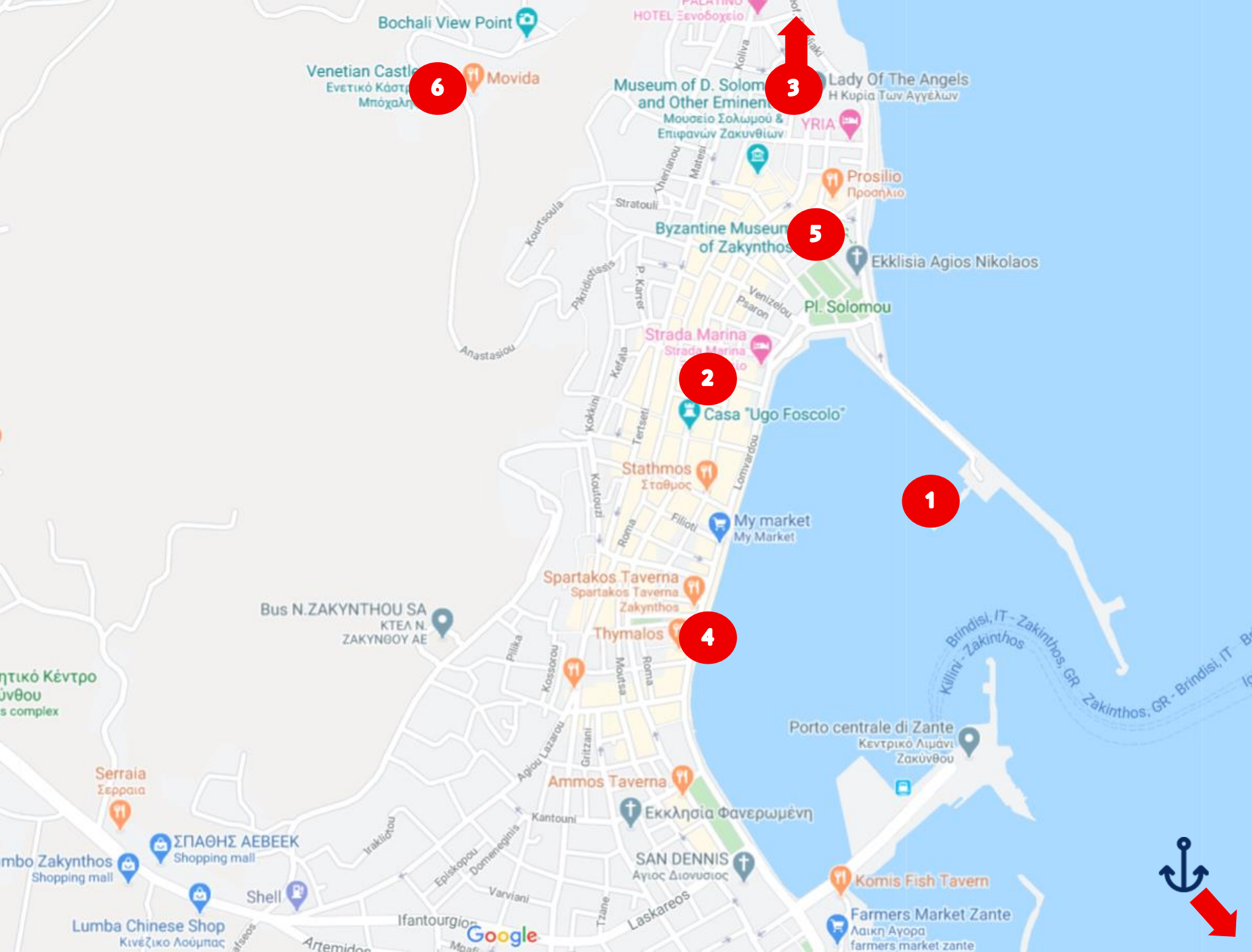

AT A GLANCE

Zakynthos is a Greek island in the Ionian Sea and a well-known summer resort. The harbour city of Zakynthos is the capital and major hub, centred around waterfront Solomos Square. Popular beaches like Agios Nikolaos, Alykanas and Tsilivi offer swimming and water sports.

When we arrive into Zakynthos we'll drop anchor and tender into the port. The drop off point for tender will be in front of the town at the pier, from here it is only a short 5-10 minute walk into town.

Taxis are available at the pier. Agree a charge before you begin the journey.

There is a bus service known as the KTEL bus service which is located near the port. The timetables and the prices of tickets are there, you can buy one either at the bus station or in the bus.

DON'T MISS OUT ON

Shipwreck cove, sometimes referred to as "Smugglers Cove". It is situated in the North of the island and is one of the most photographed attractions on the island.

Solomon square: in the heart of town has many different coffee shops & restaurants. The square is also surrounded by beautiful buildings including the Byzantine museum & the Church of Saint Nicholas.

Regular **shopping** hours in Zante are 13.30 & only some of the tourist shops will remain open during siesta time. The main shopping street is Alexandrou Roma, which runs parallel to the waterfront.

Located South from Zakynthos port it's a large sandy **beach** popular for sunbathing and water sports with plenty of restaurants and bars. Approx. 15 minutes in a taxi.

Please follow any local regulations in regards to Covid-19 precaution measures. You may need to show proof of vaccination at some venues so please keep it handy.

EXCURSION OF THE DAY

Smuggler's cove: On this tour, you'll be driven to Porto Vromi – an area surrounded by myths and legends. From here, a scenic boat ride will take you across to the beach at Smuggler's Cove. You'll have an hour to take a look around the shipwreck, swim in the light blue waters, or simply lounge on the beach. It's one of the most scenic spots in all of Greece, so you'll want to bring your camera along.
